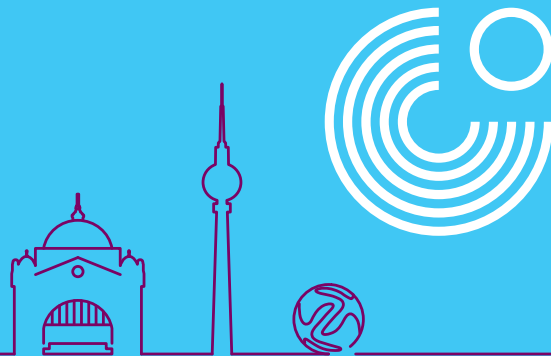

Based on remarkable true events and adapted from Dietrich Garstka's eponymous book, *The Silent Revolution* is a captivating Cold War-era drama that recently enjoyed its World Premiere in the Special Gala of the 2018 Berlinale International Film Festival.

It's 1956 and during a visit to West Berlin, high school students Theo and Kurt witness dramatic footage of the Budapest uprising. Back at in Stalinstadt, they spontaneously hold a two minute's silence during class in solidarity with the victims of the Hungarian struggle against Soviet oppression. But the gesture causes much bigger ripples than expected. The People's Education Minister condemns the action as a counterrevolutionary act and demands that the ringleader be named, forcing the students to choose between standing together or not.

Visible only to those like them and to children, Daniel (Bruno Ganz, also in this year's *In Times of Fading Light*) and Cassiel (Otto Sander, *Das Boot*, 1981) are two angels, who have existed since long before humankind. Along with several other angels, they wander around West Berlin, observing and preserving life, sometimes trying to provide comfort to the troubled. When Daniel falls in love with a trapeze artist called Marion he decides to become human, even though that means giving up immortality. Peter Falk, playing himself as a former angel, has already taken that fateful step and urges Daniel to leave eternity behind too.

The story is told from the point of view of the angels, who see the world in black and white. It is not until Daniel becomes human that the world of colour reveals itself to him...

When biology student Jule finds out she is pregnant, she sets out for Portugal to find her boyfriend Alex. Traveling in a rusty Mercedes "303" campervan, she picks up hitchhiker Jan at a gas station outside Berlin. While on the road, they have impassioned and deep conversations about capitalism, human nature, love and the meaning of life. Their trip becomes an emotional roller coaster, which finds them desperately trying not to fall in love with each other...

Hans Weingartner (*The Edukators*, 2004) sends his protagonists on an exciting road trip across Europe, with their palpable chemistry igniting their hot-button conversations. Socio-political depth and a tender love story meld into a captivating, light-handed, profoundly moving boy-meets-girl story.

In this road-trip adventure, *Fack Ju Göthe* star Jella Haase makes an unexpected discovery: the further she travels away from home, the closer she gets to herself.

Marleen is a young woman whose life hasn't started yet. Already in her early 20s, she still lives at home with her parents and has no goals or aspirations to speak of. Stuck in a rut that seems impossible to overcome, even her beloved big brother (the ever-popular German star Matthias Schweighöfer) can't save her from what looks like a permanent slump. When a personal tragedy shakes her awake Marleen embarks on an adventure she's clearly not prepared for: a ship is waiting in Hamburg to sweep her off to Antarctica. But how is she supposed to get there with only eight euros in her pocket? It's the beginning of a storybook journey that's just as funny as it is emotionally poignant.

The chance meeting of two people at the darkest moments of their lives leads to a bright new beginning in this bleakly humorous comedy.

Terminally ill Arthur (Josef Hader, *Stefan Zweig: Farewell to Europe*, 2016) travels to Amsterdam seeking to end his life, though his planned last opulent trip is constantly disrupted: on the plane a child knocks over his glass of sparkling and on the eve of his scheduled death, he hears loud noises from the hotel room next door. There he finds Claire (Hannah Hoekstra, Berlin International Film Festival Shooting Star 2017), a young Dutch woman who wants to commit suicide. He manages to stop her, and she takes him into the night life of Amsterdam, each with the intention of changing the other's mind within the last few hours allotted to them.

After Sophie and Jessica witnessed a brutal crime when they were kids, Jessica promised her younger sister to always protect her. As they grow older, this promise becomes an obsession. Now, Jessica suffers from paranoia and sees a threat to her and her sister everywhere. But Sophie just wants to live a normal life without fear, without her sister; she wants to become a pianist and to fall in love. When the perpetrators are released from prison after 20 years, Jessica is shocked and wants to confront them. But an accident changes everything. Jessica's promise turns into a life-threatening nightmare.

Kienle masterfully helms this suspenseful psychological thriller; keeping some of his best surprises for the shocking finale.

Set in the 1960s in a provincial Austrian town, the bright nine-year-old Johanna discovers that her hometown's idyllic façade hides historic traumas. Growing up a good Catholic girl, life changes for Johanna when her blind grandmother Ruth (German Academy Award winner Hannelore Elsner) finally reveals the family secret about their Jewish past. The local pastor and religious teacher make Johanna feel unwelcome, and neighbours ostracize the family. Johanna, however, decides to embrace, not hide, her heritage, and reinvents herself as "Hanna."

It's medieval times in Germany's Black Forest: Peter and Lisbeth are two young but unfortunate lovers living in a rigid rural community. She comes from a wealthy family of glassblowers; he is a poor coal worker on the lower end of society. To become rich and respected, Peter makes a pact with a devil named Dutch Michael (Moritz Bleibtreu, *Run Lola Run*, 1998), who rips out his heart and replaces it with a stone. Robbed of all feeling, Lisbeth no longer recognizes Peter as the man she once loved and turns against him. There is only one way for him to put things straight: Peter must get his heart back.

Based on the dark fairy tale written by Wilhelm Hauff in 1827, *Heart of Stone* tells a mythical love story set against the mysterious backdrop of the Black Forest.

Just before the fall of the Berlin Wall, the birthday celebrations of an East German family turn into a tragicomical moment of political and personal breakdown.

But in the living room of the Powileits, time stands still. It's Wilhelm's (Bruno Ganz, also in this year's *Wings of Desire*) 90th birthday. A former resistance fighter and exile, he is an unapologetically hardline communist veteran. His wife Charlotte invited neighbours and friends to celebrate this special occasion. While everybody does their best to pretend that the outside world is still as it was, the imminent collapse of the system they've long submitted to sees this Last Supper grow increasingly disorderly. The ensemble cast, headed by Ganz is superb.

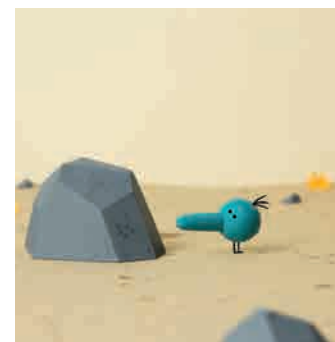

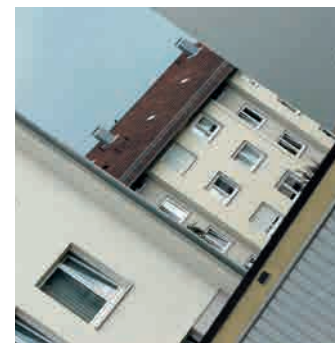

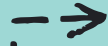
